A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL TO TRANSFER FUNDS DUE TO UNFORESEEN EXPENDITURES TO INCREASE APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY FOR CONTRACTED SERVICES RELATED TO ELECTRICAL INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, certain expenditures cannot be accurately estimated during the budget process, these conditions being the actual expenditures related to the costs for contracted electrical inspection services based on the contract with Marion County; and
