A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 10-20 AND RESOLUTION NO. 10-25, ESTABLISHING FEES, AND AUTHORIZING THE YEAR-ROUND COLLECTION OF PARKING FEES AT THE SILVERTON MARINE PARK

WHEREAS, The City established the Silverton Marine Park (the Marine Park) behind its dam on Silver Creek and has jurisdiction and exercises regulatory control over the parking areas at the Marine Park (SMC Chapter 12.50); and

WHEREAS, The Council, by Resolutions No. 10-20 and No. 10-25, established seasonal parking fees for the Marine Park; and

WHEREAS, The Council wishes to collect the parking fees at the Marine Park on a year-round basis in order to recover the operating cost of a new credit card payment kiosk; and

WHEREAS, The amount of the parking fees will remain the same as those established by Resolution No. 10-25 but may be revised in the future by a general Fee Resolution of the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SILVERTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Effective immediately, the parking fees at the Marine Park shall be assessed and collected on a year-round basis.

Section 2: That the fees for parking at the Marine Park shall be as follows:

Day Use:

Personal Vehicles:	\$2 per day
Commercial Vehicles/Buses:	\$5 per day


Annual Pass:

Silverton Resident:	\$20 per year
Silverton Resident – Senior (over 60):	\$15 per year
Non-Resident:	\$30 per year
Non-Resident – Senior (over 60):	\$25 per year

Section 3: That the parking fees for the Marine Park will be reviewed annually during the preparation of the budget and may be revised in the future by a general Fee Resolution of the City Council.

Section 4: That this resolution is and shall be effective after its passage by the City Council.
