A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL TO TRANSFER FUNDS DUE TO UNFORESEEN EXPENDITURES TO INCREASE APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY TO COVER THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE DEQ VIOLATION AND THE APPROVAL OF DEQ TO COMPLETE A SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECT (SEP)

WHEREAS, certain expenditures cannot be accurately estimated during the budget process, these conditions being the cost of the DEQ violation and whether the City would be allowed to use any of the violation charge towards a SEP; and

WHEREAS, Local Budget Law, ORS 294.463, authorizes the transferring of funds in these situations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SILVERTON, AS FOLLOWS:
