**A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL TO TRANSFER FUNDS DUE TO UNFORESEEN EXPENDITURES TO INCREASE APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY TO COVER THE COSTS OF ABIQUA INTAKE MODEM REPLACEMENT, SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE GENERATOR INSTALLATION, AND SODIUM HYDROXIDE STORAGE TANK LEAK REPAIR AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

**WHEREAS**, certain expenditures cannot be accurately estimated during the budget process, these conditions being higher costs than anticipated for modem replacement, chlorine generator installation, and chemical storage tank leak repair for the water treatment plant; and

**WHEREAS**, Local Budget Law, ORS 294.463, authorizes the transferring of funds in these situations.
