Date: 4-26-20 (Sunday)

20-2181 1207 Vandalism Schlador St.

A caller reported damage to property at this location. An officer checked the area and located the damage. No suspect leads at this time.

20-2182 1248 Suspicious Vehicle Pine St.

An officer observed a vehicle parked near a building under construction at this location. The officer contacted the responsible party who was working inside the warehouse. No further action.
